## 5 Oct 24

The crane company parked the crane in front last night and we moved our cars out of the way last night. This morning they showed up around 0830 and we signed the paperwork for the tree removal from the roof. The man remarked we were their only customer who had moved their cars in advance, normally they have to wait for people to scramble in a panic to do so. Duh.



They were done by 2pm. The house shook a few times as the weight was lifted off the house.
